PLEASE READ BEFORE PUTTING SUMMER WHINNYS™ ON YOUR HORSE!

- 1. GO TO WWW.WHINNYWARMERS.COM. SCROLL DOWN TO THE BOTTOM OF THE HOME PAGE AND REVIEW THE VIDEO OF HOW TO PUT THE SOCKS ON AND TAKE THE SOCKS OFF. DOING SO WILL MAKE THIS VERY SIMPLE FOR YOU.
- A. Put the enclosed plastic bag over the hoof.
- B. Pull the sock on over the plastic bag. Get the sock completely on the leg before concerning yourself with adjusting it. The colored finishing stitch is the bottom of the sock and should be at the hoof when the sock is properly put on the leg.
- C. Before putting the hoof down on the ground, pull the plastic bag off the hoof.
- D. Adjust the sock up and down on the leg.

Summer Whinnys[™] stay up beautifully for many hours on 98% of horses and you will be pleasantly surprised at just how much activity these socks can withstand before slipping down. You may have to adjust the socks a little more in the beginning, but most horses accept the socks right away.

After the first couple of days, wash your socks to achieve the best fit. For the best results, wash and dry every week to restore the elastic and fit. **DO NOT USE BLEACH**. Wash these socks like any other socks.

Moisture enhances the antimicrobial/anti-fungal properties of these socks. You can bathe your horse while it is wearing the socks. Let the socks dry on the legs. If they get wet for any reason, simply adjust them on the leg and allow them to dry on the leg.

Brush mud and other debris off the socks before removing them to wash, but otherwise these socks will offer great protection and a clean environment around the leg even while soaking wet.

Socks may fall faster than they should for some horses. Usually the horse is fighting them, fussing with them, or is a very active horse. It could also be that you chose a size that is too large. Call us if you think you chose the wrong size. But give the horse time to get use to them! Don't just assume they don't work after one night. They work great and most horses leave them alone after awhile. The socks can come down but they will never hurt your horse, never leave raw, rubbed, spots on the legs and never cause any circulation impairments. These socks provide exceptional protection and the cleanest environment you could ever put around your horse's legs. Adjust them as needed and let your horse get use to them. You have 30 days to return the socks. Use that time! If your horse destroys a sock in the process, and you want to replace some socks, call us. We will reward you for sticking with it by giving you a steep discount on another set or replacement socks.

We've never had a horse hurt or injured because of our socks. Please note that because of the theoretically possible risk of a sock coming off or falling down and panicking the horse while being ridden, we must state that riding your horse while it's wearing Summer Whinnys™ must be at your own risk.
